

Private and small group one-on-one tutoring

By purchasing a Private Tuition package at the Alliance Française de Newcastle (“AFN”), you are agreeing to abide by the policies, procedures and regulations of the AFN.

This includes agreement with the following terms. You are also providing confirmation that the information given on enrolment is complete and correct.

Please note that private tuition is organised case-by-case by the AFN Coordinator. The AFN Coordinator works part-time and treats new requests chronologically in the order in which they are received. New requests are managed via a waiting list.

We endeavour to respond to requests in a timely manner in accordance with operational and logistical restraints. Students and/or Guardians are encouraged to apply for private tuition at least 2 weeks before they wish to begin their Package.

All students need to submit the online Private Tuition form before the AFN Coordinator can proceed with the organisation of their Package.

We encourage to apply for private tuition at least 2 weeks before you wish to begin.

WHAT HAPPENS NEXT?

The AFN coordinator will contact you to confirm the form has been received and will keep you informed about the availability of a teacher.

The AFN Coordinator will confirm with the students the day and time that suits both the student and the teacher. Once the tutoring schedule is being confirmed, the payment can be organised. Please note that the payment of the package will be required **in full** at least 72 hours before the first confirmed lesson.

Payment is available via Bank Transfer to the AFN Bank account.

If AFN does not hear from you within 3 business days of confirming the availability of a teacher by email, your teacher may be reallocated, or no longer available to take your class.

Due to changing availabilities for rooms and other facilities, the AFN is only able to confirm Private Tuition for a “foreseeable period”, i.e. up until a point where our timetable for Group Courses, or other events that affect our room allocations, changes.

AFN primarily offers Collective and Small Group Courses as a means of learning. In our busiest periods of New Terms and Sessions a delay may be expected for the attribution and creation of new sessions.

Private classes start and finish on the agreed time between tutor and student. If a student arrives late to a private lesson, the tutor may not be able to teach longer than the initial agreed time. If a student is running late, we appreciate a courtesy call.

Cancelations and changes:

In case you need to cancel or change the tutoring, please, make sure to read the following:

- All communication regarding changes or cancellation must be made **by email at contact@afnewcastle.com.au**. Please make sure to indicate in the subject of the email TUTORING CANCELLATION / TUTORING CHANGES.
Failure to notify Alliance Française de Newcastle of a lesson cancellation prior to 24 hours before the scheduled lesson time will result in the full fee being charged for the lesson. Therefore, the class will not be rescheduled. Cancellations on behalf of minors must be made by their parent/s or guardian/s.
- For shared private tuition (two or more students), no split of credit will be possible once the tuition has been organised and paid for. The Alliance Française will not be held responsible for students' changes in work commitments or personal circumstances when one student cannot attend the group tuition any more.
- In special circumstances, when a lesson is missed for medical reasons and supporting documentation is provided, a partial credit note can be organised at the discretion of Alliance Française de Newcastle and on request. All applications for a credit note or refund must be addressed by email at contact@afnewcastle.com.au
- Private Tuition packages are non-refundable. The following items are non-refundable
 1. Membership Fee (your Alliance Française Membership is valid independently from Private Tuition Sessions and still allows you to discounts on our events and movies, classes and free access to Culturethèque).
 2. Textbooks may only be refunded if they have not yet been collected from Reception.

Cancellation by AFN:

In the event of Alliance Française de Newcastle experiencing problems at the time of a scheduled lesson and we are unable to provide our regular services, we will arrange for another lesson at the earliest convenience for both student and teacher. Alternately, we will organise a credit note for future lessons.

Deferring your package

1. When a committed student is no longer able to attend class for the remainder of a package, we might be able to organise a partial credit note. Credit notes may be provided strictly in the event of one of the following unforeseen circumstances
 1. Following an accident or trauma (supporting documentation required);
 2. Medical treatment that prevents the student's completion of the package (supporting documentation required)
2. Applications for credit notes must be addressed **in writing by email to** the AFN Coordinator at contact@afnewcastle.com.au
3. Credit notes will be calculated as per the decreasing price schema for Private Tuition fees. That is, the amount of credit given will be calculated according to
 1. The number of hours originally purchased in the package;
 2. The price paid per hour for the original purchase; and
 3. The number of hours remaining to the student on the package.
4. Strict conditions apply
 1. Credit notes cannot be refunded for money;
 2. Credit notes are valid for a period of 12 months from the date that they are processed;
 3. Credit notes' validity cannot be extended;
 4. Credit notes are not transferable;

Credit notes are not valid for external products sold by l'Alliance Française such as *Alliance Française French Film Festival* tickets or events.
