2023 ENTRY TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1.HOW TO ENTER

Entry forms has to be downloaded form the Alliance Française de Newcastle website. After completing the online form, print it and attach it to your artwork.

Under 18 years entries must be submitted by an adult (parent/guardian. The curator reserves the right to refuse entry not suitable for a general audience.

2.ELIGIBILITY

The Art Prize is open to all permanent Australian residents aged 7 years and over.

3.MEDIUM

Art Prize is open to any medium painting, ceramics, photography, sculpture, poetry... it must be the original work of the exhibitor.

4.SUBJECT/THEME

Adult Awards theme: **Food Art - A Table!** Young Artists awards theme: **Circus** Let your imagination run wild! Works may be figurative or abstract.

5.PRIZES

Adult winner prize \$500 Highly commended prize \$250 Young winner prize \$150 Highly commended prize \$100

Two selected judges by the Art community will award the winners of The Alliance Française /Yves Hernot prizes.

Any work not fulfilling the entry requirements will not be accepted.

6.SALE OF ARTWORKS

All works exhibited may be for sale unless marked Not For Sale (NFS). A 30% commission will be deducted from the selling price of any artwork sold.

7.ENTRY DETAILS AND FEE

The entry fee is \$20 (inc. GST) for members and \$25 for non-members per artwork (non-refundable) with a maximum of 2 works per artist. Entry form must be downloaded and completed by the artist from the Alliance Française website and attached to the art work). Payments must be made to the Alliance Française website by credit card.

8. PREPARATION OF ARTWORK

Works must be presented ready for exhibition: ie. mounted and framed (if necessary) with 'D-ring' hanging devices attached. The artist's name, address and phone number, title of work, price or with mention Not-For-Sale. (NFS) must be clearly marked on the Entry Form.

9. SIZE OF ARTWORK

The maximum size of works is A1 print, less than 50 kilograms and 1m2 for installation.

10. DELIVERY OF WORKS

Artworks must be delivered to Alliance Francaise de Newcastle/ Joy Cumming centre, 63 Scott street Newcastle, from 04/09/2022 and 08/09/2023.

If artworks are delivered by Courier, the name of the Courier company must be noted on the entry form.

11. COLLECTION OF ARTWORKS AFTER EXHIBITION

Exhibitors must collect their works between Monday 18 September to Saturday 30 September. The Alliance Française will not be responsible for works not collected by this time. Works not collected by 30 September 2023 will be disposed of.

12. CARE /RESPONSIBILITY / INSURANCE

The Alliance Française de Newcastle will handle the works with care but cannot be held responsible if a work is lost, damaged or broken. Exhibitors may wish to arrange their own insurance.

12. COPYRIGHT

The Alliance Française reserves the right to photograph works exhibited in the gallery for the purpose of future promotion of similar events. Artist will retain copyright if their work wins and is reproduced. All necessary acknowledgements of authorship will be duly made.
