There is a limit of 2 pieces per artist, which must be an original work by the artist. All works must be for sale unless marked Not For Sale (NFS).

The artist warrants that they are the original author of the work. The work does not, to the best of the artist's knowledge, infringe the copyright or moral rights of any third party.

SUBMISSION OF ENTRY FORM & FEE Members \$20 per work, Non-members \$25 per work.

Free entry for the Youth Art prize. 20 Artworks will be selected from this category by the committee to be exhibited at the Alliance Francaise de Newcastle.

Exhibitors are required to download and complete the application form by Friday 8 September with the appropriate fee. Payment must be paid through the Alliance Française de Newcastle website by credit card. The application form must be attached to the art works on delivery at the Alliance Française at 63 Scott Street, Newcastle.

The Alliance Française committee accepts no responsibility for damage to exhibits from any cause. They reserve the right to refuse entry to, or remove, any exhibit that is unsafe or unsuitable for a general audience. Exhibitors are responsible for all costs associated with insurance of their works.
