#### CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

There is a limit of 2 pieces per artist, which must be an original work by the artist. All works must be for sale unless marked Not For Sale (NFS).

The artist warrants that they are the original author of the work. The work does not, to the best of the artist's knowledge, infringe the copyright or moral rights of any third party.

#### SUBMISSION OF ENTRY FORM FEE:

Entry for Afult Prize: Members \$7 - Non-members \$10.

Entry for the Youth Art prize: Free

Exhibitors are required to download/get a copy from AFN and complete the application form by Thursday 22nd of August. Payment must be paid through the Alliance Française de Newcastle website. The application form must be attached to the art works on delivery at the Alliance Française not later than Friday 23rd August 12pm.


### LIABILITY.

A commission of 30% including GST, will be charged on all work sold during the exhibition. At the completion of the exhibition, the artist will be remitted the balance of the value of the artwork within 14 days by bank transfer.

The artist will receive credit and be identified as the creator and the owner of the work.
